For Student Loans
On-Line Instructions

Congratulations! You qualified for a Federal Stafford Student Loan, and we have certified your student loan(s) electronically. If you want to reduce or cancel the loan(s), you will need to contact the financial aid office informing us of the change(s).

All first-time borrowers must complete the Entrance counseling session and the Master Promissory Note (MPN) before funds can be disbursed to your account (see below). If you applied and received a student loan for the prior year at Langston University, neither the Entrance counseling session nor the MPN will be required. When enrolled, your disbursement(s) will be transmitted to your LU student account after enrollment ends.

Completing the Entrance or Exit Counseling Session

Completing the Federal Stafford MPN

- ✘ Access Langston University Website > www.lunet.edu > Financial Aid > “Apply On-Line for Stafford Loan.”
 - ✘ If you are first-time user, you must register through Open Net
 - ✘ Use your Open Net User ID and Password to start the application process
 - ✘ Select “Loans in Process” Tab
 - ✘ Select “GO” button and start the Process
1. You will need two (2) adult references that do not share a common United States Address.
 2. During this process, you will be given the option of “Electronic Signature.” We encourage you to complete the Electronic Signature (e-sign) to expedite the disbursement process.
 3. If you forget your user ID and/or password, please call 1-888-272-5543 to get it reset.
 4. If you do not complete your online promissory note within 60 days, you will receive it in the mail at the current address we have available on our system.
